CMS Requiring New 90-Day Transition Period for Active/Current Treatments for Part C Drugs and Services Beginning Jan.1, 2024

Beginning Jan. 1, 2024, Centers for Medicare Care & Medicaid Services (CMS) is requiring Medical Mutual to offer new Medicare Plan members a 90-day continuity of care, or transition period, for active/current treatments for Part C drugs and services. To ensure that your patients do not experience any disruption in treatment after the 90-day transition period, please initiate an organization determination at your earliest convenience.
