MedFlex is currently available to small, midsize and large groups across Ohio.



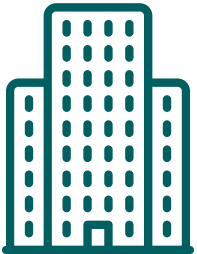
SMALL GROUPS (50 OR FEWER EMPLOYEES)

Groups of 50 employees or fewer can offer the product through Affordable Care Act (ACA)-compliant plans (no medical questionnaires required) or through multiple employer welfare arrangement (MEWA) plans.



MIDSIZE GROUPS (51—99 EMPLOYEES)

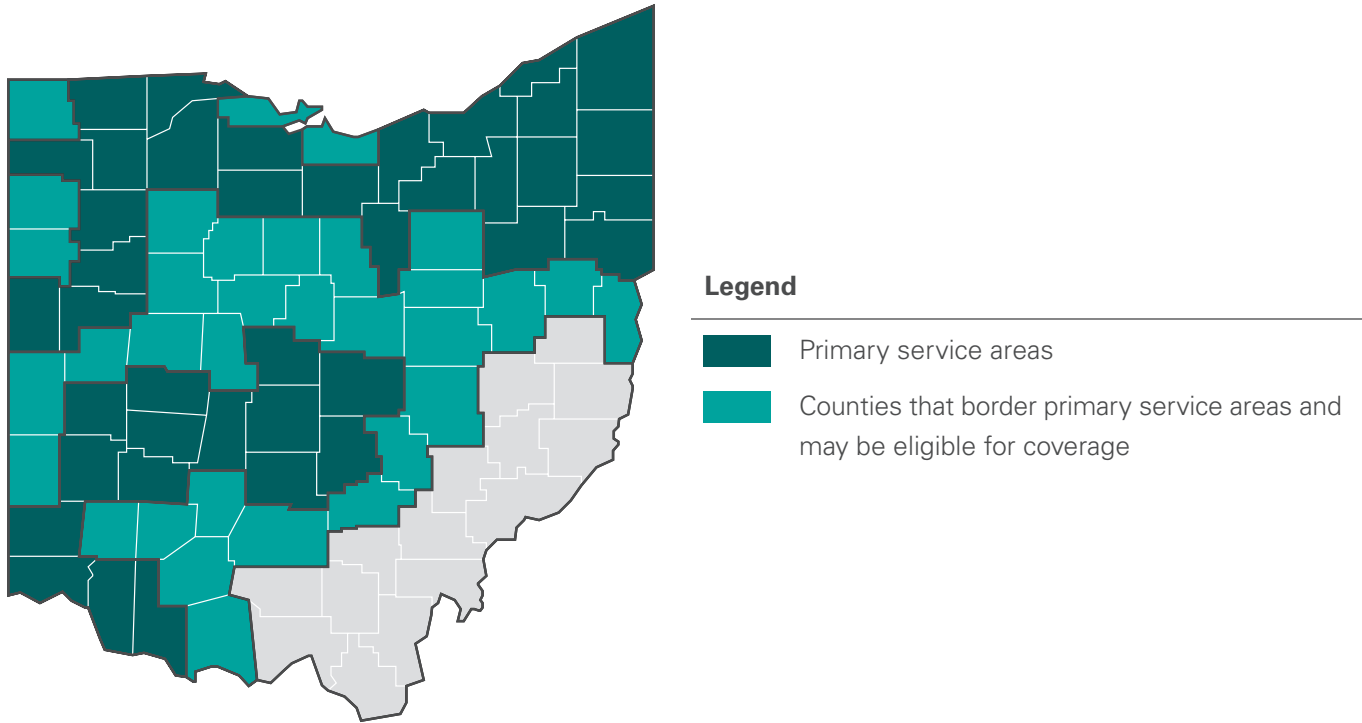
The MedFlex network makes it easy to meet the needs of your employees with more than 3,000 primary care physicians, 10,000 specialists and 70 hospitals across the state.

Benefits Overview

MedFlex gives employers and employees access to complete benefits, excellent care and cost control measures to help manage premiums and out-of-pocket costs. As a non-gatekeeper HMO, it doesn't require members to coordinate care through a primary care physician, so they can access specialists directly and save money. However, it is suggested that members select a primary care physician as regular health screenings can lead to better health outcomes and reduced costs.

Employers with 50 or fewer employees can access ACA-compliant benefit plans. Employers with 51–99 employees may choose from a suite of standard plans. Customized plans are available for employers with 100 or more employees.



Pharmacy Benefits

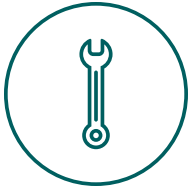
A wide variety of generic, brand and specialty medications are available through the National Preferred Plus formulary. These medications can be ordered through the Walgreens Advantage Network, which includes most major national and regional pharmacies, such as Walgreens and Discount Drug Mart.

Additionally, safety controls are available through a fraud, waste and abuse program while cost and utilization controls are included through programs such as Coverage Management, Specialty Drug Solutions, Generic Incentive, Mandatory Mail and Compound Drug Management.



Out-of-Network Restrictions

This plan only covers out-of-network benefits for medical emergencies. Emergencies are always covered at any hospital regardless of network status. The member is responsible for the costs of non-emergency care received out of network.



Tools and Resources

Nurse Line

MedFlex includes access to Nurse Line, where a registered nurse is available to answer health-related questions 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The Nurse Line is available by phone or through the member website, My Health Plan. Members and dependents can use Nurse Line to determine what type of care is needed.

Through My Health Plan, the secure Wellness Portal on Medical Mutual's member website and application, employees can check their benefits, view claims and deductible information, as well as access their spending accounts.
