

Diabetes Telemonitoring Program



About the Program

If you are an AultCare member and have been diagnosed with diabetes, AultCare's diabetes telemonitoring program is available to you at no additional cost.

By participating in this program, telemonitoring equipment will be used to report your blood glucose level and sends your results to your assigned registered nurse. The nurse will monitor your results to watch for trends or potential risks.

Throughout this program your results are monitored and specific trends can be identified. The data can be shared with your physicians as needed or on your appointment days for records of your data. Educational materials are also available to help you understand all aspects of your condition.



Professional Support

In this program, you are assigned a registered nurse who will closely monitor your diabetes through use of your equipment. Your nurse will provide support and answer questions you have regarding your condition.



At Home Monitoring

You can use equipment to monitor your diabetes from the comfort of your home.

Diabetes Prevention Education



About the Education

If you are an AultCare member and at risk for developing diabetes, AultCare's diabetes prevention education is available to you at no additional cost.

In this program, an AultCare registered nurse can provide you with the guidance and resources you need to lower your risk for developing diabetes. The nurse will provide coaching, support, and answer any questions you have regarding your condition. Educational materials are sent to your home and will help guide you on healthy eating and exercise, as well as help you understand factors that trigger unhealthy habits.

During the first six months of the program, the nurse will help you focus on healthy eating habits to decrease your weight/body mass index by 5-7% and encourage participation in an exercise program with your physician's approval. During the next six months, the nurse will provide education to help maintain weight loss and motivation.



Professional Support

In this program, you are assigned a registered nurse who will provide support in monitoring your risk for developing diabetes. Your nurse can answer questions you have regarding your condition.



Quantifiable Goals

A nurse will provide you with healthy eating and exercise goals to better manage your risk for developing diabetes.
