

### **Tiered Network Approach**

However, in the event that care or treatment is required outside of these healthcare systems, Medical Mutual's SuperMed PPO providers are available, as part of the second tier coverage available through WellFlex.


2 The Cigna PPO Network refers to the health care providers (doctors, hospitals, specialists) contracted as part of the Cigna PPO for Shared Administration.

They will have direct access to TriHealth and St. Elizabeth physicians for scheduling. Regular health screenings through a primary care physician can lead to better health outcomes and reduced costs.

It is a great option for employers with employees who live or work in the Greater Cincinnati area. Standard benefit plans are available for groups with 51-99 employees, with customizable plans available for groups with 100 or more employees.
